Dear Sir

I notice by the N.Y. Observer that you are to have a meeting of gentlemen at the Bible House on Saturday to consider the case of Pacific University_

As Mssrs. Hovery & Bell are both operating in this City-- there ought to be some comparison of notes & I therefore propose a meeting at my office to [illegible word] Friday at 2 oclock P.M. -- that I may see yourself & Messrs. Bell & Hovery together-- Without some consultation these several operations are liable to clash at least to cross each other

Mr. Bell proposed a meeting at the Bible House-- at the suggestion I believe of Dr Adams--but it was neither my opinion that if we had any at all it might be best to have one where we could bring the lifting power of each & every one of these particular operations.

I shall ask Mr. Bell to be here tomorrow--
