Dear Sir,

Accompanying this I send one copy of the last Report of our Society just from the Press. Tomorrow will send you 50 copies by the National Exports Co & put on the bundle "to be called for" I sent copies by the Steamer of today to Messrs Atkinson & Lyman.

In looking over the Report & estimating our progress last year please notice what is said about the "provision for Illinois College" p.p. 24—26 that provision as really disposes of the work of the Society to the extent of \$13,739.70 as if the cash were in hand & my expectation is that the pledge by "a graduate of the College" (p. 24) will amount perhaps \$20,000

It is rather my opinion that you had better come to New York after finishing Vermont no doubt something & perhaps something handsome can be realized in this city & Brooklyn.

Have you ever written a letter of acknowledgement to Mr. Hoadly of the Panama R.R. for your free ticket? If not it strikes me that it would be well to do it. Also to acknowledge the receipt of it to our Treasurer with a specification of its value.

If you do not come to New York let me know where to direct letters.
