Driving Directions to Pacific University's Hillsboro Campus:

The Hillsboro Campus is about 20 miles West of Portland in downtown Hillsboro.

1. FROM THE NORTH...

Traveling southbound on Interstate 5, take the 405 exit West, follow signs and exit to Highway 26 West (Ocean Beaches/Oregon Zoo).

FROM THE SOUTH...

Traveling northbound on Interstate 5, take 217 exit North, follow signs and exit to Highway 26 West.

FROM THE EAST...

Traveling westbound on Interstate 84, follow signs and exit to Interstate 5 southbound, follow signs to 405, and to Highway 26 West.

2. THEN...FROM HIGHWAY 26...

Once on Highway 26, take Exit 64 for 185th Avenue. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Hillsboro/Beaverton and merge onto NW 185th Avenue. In 0.2 miles, turn right onto NW Evergreen Parkway. In 1.8 miles, turn left on NE Cornelius Pass Road. In 0.5 miles, turn right onto NE Cornell Rd. Travel 4.1 miles and remain in the right lane. The road will fork, and you will want to turn right onto East Main Street. In 0.2 miles, turn left onto SE 8th Avenue. Pacific's Hillsboro Building 2 (HPC2) will be on your left. Continue on SE 8th Ave across the TriMet MAX train tracks to find parking. The general public may park on the first or second levels of the large parking garage structure off of SE 8th Ave.

Public Transportation:

Parking at the Hillsboro Campus is extremely limited. Public transportation is strongly recommended. The [MAX Blue Line](#) runs immediately past the Hillsboro Campus, offering convenient access from anywhere in the Portland Metro Area.

There are several [park-and-ride](#) stations along the MAX route with 24-hour parking and bike lockers. The closest park-and-ride lots to the Hillsboro Campus are:

- Orenco Station, 4 stops away
- Fairplex Station, 2 stops away
- County Garage, 2 stops away
